Raven: (Panicked) I'd almost forgotten. Kelex, help me get out of here!

Kelex: It seems the key to the fortress was shattered, the only other exit is via Zeta-

tube, although it's not exactly reliable in such climates at this. Your atoms

could be...

If it's my only chance, show me the way Raven:




Scene 2 **Alaunus**

Raven sees the battle continue overhead. She raises her staff, the eye glows, and the battle is hidden from the view of the warriors.

Raven: They must focus on the challenges. Awaken (she slams her staff on the

> ground and everyone is awake) I hope you are well rested, for more trials await you today and one of you must depart at day's end. The warrior with the fewest lives and rings will be given one final trial to prove their worth. But

that is later, come (she leads the warriors away)



Raven:

Courage in the face of adversity as a vital skill for a true warrior. In the trees, lie 3 golden rings, to grasp them, you must climb to the platform and jump from it. You will be tethered to ensure your safety but fail to make the leap and you shall lose a life. Lerdan, I choose you to go first



Raven: Are you ready? Lerdan: Yes, Raven

Raven: Then let the challenge (she slams her staff down) begin

Lerdan takes to the tree and climbs it quickly, the height does not seem to have any effect on his progress. Soon he makes it to the platform, eyes on the rings, he jumps, grabbing the 2 further gold rings.

Lerdan: I felt that the Leap of Faith was great because I'm not afraid heights and

getting two rings is good because it's better than no rings at all



Raven: Lerdan secured 2 rings, can you match his performance? Are you ready?


Denal: Yes, Raven

Raven: Then let the challenge (she slams her staff down) begin

Denal makes the climb, his progress is slower but the objective of this challenge was never speed and he never thinks to look down. He makes it to the top, and makes his leap, grabbing all 3 rings.

Denal: I'm not afraid of heights, so I knew I could take my time and hopefully

maximise my results. Which is exactly what I did.



Raven: Are you ready? Valtho: Yes, Raven

Raven: Then let the challenge (she slams her staff down) begin

Valtho takes to the tree, climbing it at speed, he makes it to the stop and takes in the height in which he is now. He breathes slowly, preparing himself before making the leap, and a mighty one it was, 2 rings gathered.

Valtho: I felt good going into Leap of Faith and the climbing went very well. Once I

caught my breath I knew I'd have the confidence to make the leap. That's a

good start to my day.



Raven: Let the challenge (she slams her staff down) begin

Pale takes to the climb, showing no fear as his height allows him to ascend with great haste. At the top, the rings become his focus, he makes the leap, and his focus pays off as all 3 rings available are in his grasp

Pale:

That challenge was so easy especially as not only I have no fear of heights but I am also used to them given my experience on roller-coasters so there was no way I was losing that challenge. I was however focused on gaining all of the rings so when I collected all of them I was very happy as this keeps my position within the top 4.



Raven: Let the challenge (she slams her staff down) begin

Hamras starts his climb, fearlessly moving at a considerable pace, the climb proves little challenge for him, and soon the rings are in his sights. He makes the leap, but unfortunately, he fails to grab any of the rings.

Hamras: I was confident that I would get at least a ring in this challenge, but

unfortunately, I am too short so I only really got my fingertips on the rings.



Raven: Let the challenge (she slams her staff down) begin

Etoney makes the climb and does so fearlessly and at a good pace. Before long he has made it to the top, he looks at the rings, ready to make the all-important leap. He does so, grasping 2 rings as he descends to the ground.

Etoney: Well at the beginning of the challenge I was not overly confident as I was

having flashbacks to loch leap which was a similar style of challenge but as I was climbing I just cleared my head of any negative thoughts and I managed

to get 2 rings so I think that's a decent way to start the day.



Raven: Let the challenge (she slams her staff down) begin

Leyad climbs the tree fearlessly, with her height serving her well. Before long she has made it to the top and has her eyes on the rings. Without a moment's hesitation she makes the jump, and lays claim to 2 rings

Leyad: I really enjoyed this challenge! The jump was a lot of fun to make and I got

two rings! While I would have liked to get all three, this is 100% a step in the

right direction!



Raven: (She slams her staff down) begin

Kanem begins her ascent, she struggles but makes progress and before long she reaches the top. She looks out from the platform, taking a few deep breaths, she jumps and grabs a single gold ring, she smiles at the result

Kanem: During Leap of Faith, I was nervous a little about whether I could make the

leap but I reminded myself I've climbed to the observation deck of a tall building with my older sister before so I can handle this. I'm glad I got a ring

and I am optimistic that the rest of today will go well for me.



Raven: (Slams her staff down) begin

Abbli makes the climb, holding his nerve and shifting himself further and further until he reaches the top. He puts his focus on the rings and makes his leap, grasping a single ring on his descent to the ground.

Abbli: I have quite a fear of heights but I was pretty happy to manage to get one

ring out of it.



Raven: Tonro, you have shown fear of heights previously but you must overcome

that here if you are to preserve your lives. Are you ready?

Tonro: Yes, Raven

Raven: Then have courage and let the challenge (she slams her staff down) begin

Tonro wills himself to climb, remembering the words of encouragement from key descent. Slowly but surely, he makes the climb to the top. He looks out, terrified of what he's about to do, but he does it anyway and grabs one ring on his descent.

Tonro: I wasn't sure I was gonna be able to do that challenge, but I knew if I didn't it

would haunt me and I even got a ring out of it.


Raven: Well done warriors, all of you have succeeded here and your lives remain in-

tact, Denal, Pale, you each earned 3 rings in this trial





Raven: Lerdan, Valtho, Etoney, Leyad, each of you grasped 2 golden rings, which I now add to your standards



Raven: Kanem, Abbli, Tonro, you each managed to grasp a single ring



Raven: Hamras, you made the leap, but failed to grab any gold, your lives remain in tact





Raven: Warriors, our path ahead lies on the other side of the loch, as do the golden

treasure rings you seek. Swim quickly and you will earn your rewards, but should you finish either last or second to last, you will forfeit a life. Are you

ready?

Warriors: Yes, Raven!

Raven: Then let the challenge (her voice echoes) begin (she slams her staff down and

suddenly everyone's in swimming gear)

The warriors all jump into the water of the loch. They being their swim towards the finish. Etoney and Hamras quickly take the lead over their fellow warriors, whilst Denal, Tonro, Abbli and Pale begin to fall behind.

The ice-cold waters of the loch take their hold over everyone, but the warriors maintain their determination, powering through the treacherous waters, gold in their sights. Kanem begins to fall towards the back of the pack

Positions seem unchanging but as they continue towards the end of the loch, the gaps are starting to grow. Etoney has taken the lead, with Hamras following behind her, Lerdan is close behind Hamras, but Valtho is less close in 4th. Etoney makes it to land first, grabbing 3 gold rings.

It takes 8 seconds for Hamras to join Etoney on land, grabbing 3 gold rings for his standard also, but only 4 seconds for Lerdan to make it to shore and grab the 2 rings available to him. Time passes as the other warriors continue.

6 seconds after Lerdan made it to shore, Valtho arrives, taking 2 rings for his standard, the pressure is on the remaining warriors as gold will only be awarded to the next 2 to arrive. 2 seconds later, Leyad lays claim to a ring.

With only 1 ring left for the remaining 5 warriors, all of them are giving their all, it is Kanem who makes it to shore first and grabs the final ring. Denal, Abbli and Pale are near neck and neck as they approach the finish, but Tonro is not far behind either.

Denal makes it to shore 7th, with Abbli making it mere milliseconds later, and Pale only milliseconds behind. Such a short delay will cost him dearly, as it will for Tonro, who arrives only 4 seconds later.

Kanem: While swimming the Deep Loch, I was trying not to focus on how cold the

water was and instead focus on getting to shore and preserving my lives since I don't swim very often. I am glad I did manage to get a single ring and now I

need only 3 more to win back a life.

Hamras: I am a very confident swimmer so I was almost certain I would get some rings

in this challenge; but I wasn't expecting to get three rings! I guess this makes

up for my pitiful jump in Leap of Faith.

Denal: I knew this was going to be a struggle, and I was in real trouble halfway

through. I still don't know how I managed to preserve my lives in this

challenge, I was almost dead in the water.

Valtho: Deep Loch was a tough challenge, but I'm really pleased that my stamina held

up nicely. The water was very cold, but once you got going it was okay.

Finishing in 4th was decent, especially as I got 2 rings, which I thought was a

lot!

Tonro: I'm surprised I did this badly in deep loch as I'm usually a very strong

swimmer, guess the others were just a bit stronger

Lerdan: As I was swimming, I was thinking of just making it to shore, no matter what

position I was gonna be in, and I wasn't expecting to get two rings in this

challenge.

Etoney: The only thought that was going through my head was keep going keep going

because I knew as soon as I started to pull away from the rest of the warriors I would be able to win as long as I kept going in the water which was much colder than I thought it would be so I was very pleased to win this challenge

and I'm hoping this good run continues with future challenges.

Pale: Part way through the swim I lost my energy as I am not too good at

conserving my energy but I was still clinging on to hope given it was so close between myself Denal and Abbli in the end. After that challenge, I felt so angry as I ought to have gained at least one ring given normally I would be

able to handle to swim in cold waters.

Leyad: I was a bit nervous in the challenge as the water was really cold and it was

really tiring! However, I was determined to win some rings and keep all my lives so I just kept swimming and luckily I was quick enough to get a ring!


Raven: Etoney, Hamras. You proved to be the strongest swimmers, and have each


earned 3 golden rings






Raven: Lerdan, Valtho, you finished in respectable times, 2 rings are awarded to each of you. Valtho, with these rings, you earn back another life





Raven: Kanem, Leyad, you made it to shore in time to grab a single ring each. Leyad, you too earn back a life





Raven: Denal, Abbli, you were too late for gold, but your lives remain in tact





Raven: Pale, Tonro, you made it to shore last, and each must forfeit a life





Raven:

When an enemy is too powerful to match toe-to-toe, stealth is an important ally. The demons that stand between us and the rings are blind, but (she raises her staff and a foghorn is sounded, the demons begin swinging their war-axes) those war axes are deadly if touched. You will race in pears, gathering the gold rings as you go, but beware, the rings have chimes attached, so balance speed with care. Lerdan, you lead this band of warriors, and Tonro, you are in last place. You shall go first





Raven: (Whispers) let the challenge begin

Lerdan and Tonro both start along their paths, they're quiet enough that the demons don't hear them. They're quickly reaching for the first of the rings, they both secure them but with the chimes now attached, they're in danger.

They proceed towards the second set of rings, but Tonro is too fast and ends up attracting the demons' attention, eventually being claimed by one. Lerdan manages to securely get the second ring and proceeds past the second demon to the final ring at the end.

Lerdan: I wasn't nervous by Tonro's performance in this challenge, but as soon as he

got caught, I was scared that the same would happen to me, but I just

remained focused and took the final ring





Raven: (Whispers) let the challenge begin

Both warriors take care as they proceed towards the first ring, and the first demon. They soon reach out for the first ring; the chimes begin to ring but they are thankfully out of range of the demons' weapons.

With the ring secure, the warriors start to walk towards the second ring, but Denal is too hasty, and too loud, and the demon soon claims him. Abbli makes it to the second ring and manages to grasp it but in doing so makes too much noise, the demon claims him as well.





Raven:

(Whispers) Too much haste and the demons attack, too little gives the advantage to your opponent, are you ready? (The warriors nod) then let the challenge begin

The warriors progress towards the first ring and reach out for them, they grab them but Kanem's begins making noise. The demon swings his axe and although out of range, it blocks her movement and allows Valtho to get ahead.

Valtho reaches out and grabs the second ring as the demon calms and Kanem attempts to make up for lost time. It's too late though as Valtho has past the second demon and reaches the end of the course, grabbing the final ring.

Valtho: I thought Eyeless Demons would be difficult, I mean those axes are massive! I

was nervous at the start, but once Kanem's chimes rang and I got the lead I felt more confident in my abilities. I've now moved up into second, which is

great

Kanem: I was nervous about Valtho's performance since I was not sure if either of us

would win and unfortunately, I wasn't able to get over my nerves hence why I

lost the challenge. Congratulations to him for doing so well.





Raven: (Whispers) begin

Both warriors set out towards the first ring. They are quick to grab it and seem neck and neck. They progress carefully towards the second ring, neither of them are loud enough to awaken the demons that await them

Both warriors grab the second ring, they move cautiously past the second demon, trying to ensure they don't sabotage their chances by getting claimed by the demon. They pass it, and race to the finish and Leyad is the first there, grabbing the final ring.

Hamras: If I was paired with anyone else I think I would've won, but my reactions were

slightly too slow when running for the ring. Now that I'm in the bottom half of

the leader board I have a lot to make up for.

Leyad: I was really worried about Hamras as we were neck and neck throughout the

whole challenge and we both managed to get past both the demons.

However, I was just a little bit faster than him and that let me get to the final

ring before he did, which means I'm up in 5th place now!





Raven: (Whispers) begin

The warriors begin their route to the first ring. With no chimes yet attached, they are not easily heard by the demons. They both reach out to grab the first ring, Pale grabs his first but Etoney is not far behind.

The warriors progress towards the second ring but both are too speedy as they have the demons' attention. The demon calms and soon they're reaching out for the second rings. Again, Pale has a lead, which he then assures by moving to the final ring.

Pale: I am quite light on my feet, and I have very fast reactions so that challenge

did prove quite easy for me however Etoney did put up a good fight as we were both very good at keeping quiet at the right time. However, I was just so determined to win that challenge so I just focused on gaining the rings and I

am so glad I managed to pull this off.


Etoney: I must admit I was pretty happy with being paired up against Pale because I

knew he'd prove to be a good challenge but unfortunately in this challenge he was just quicker than me so I lost a life but there's no point in being down there are plenty more challenges to come so more chances to gain rings and

Lerdan, Valtho, Leyad, Pale, you each took gold in this challenge, and have earned 3 rings for your efforts. Lerdan, you have won back yet another life









Raven: Kanem, Hamras, Etoney, you may have evaded the demons, but you were beaten to the rings, the price is a life



Raven: Denal, Abbli, Tonro, I have restored you from the demons' grasp (she brings them back with her staff) but the cost for doing so is a life







Abbli: When Denal lost, all I had to do was take it slow but I didn't. I royally messed

up

Denal: It was going to happen sooner or later, but it's still disappointing to lose a life.

I got too cocky knowing I was racing Abbli, and I paid the price.

Tonro: I've never had steady hands, so I knew this would be a challenge, but now I'm

down to 3 lives.

Raven: Abbli, Tonro, you are falling well behind, you must succeed in the challenges

to come, or you will fall by day's end

Scene 3

Fortress of Solitude

The figure is typing into the fortress computer system, Raven and Kelex approach enter the chamber

Kelex: The zeta tube is just across the hallway

Raven: But he stands between us and it

Kelex: I sense his presence, but I cannot detect his exact location, I'll run a

diagnostic. (Raven looks at his staff)

Raven: That isn't a staff of power, the wood isn't even oak. (He sees a blue stone

inside the staff) what is that?

Scene 4

Alaunus

Escape the Cage

Raven: (Walking through the forest) it seems the warriors have been anxious to

move onto the next challenge (he staff glows red) such greed can only land

them in trouble (she walks into a clearing and finds warriors in cages, with others trying to free them) the key to escape is in front of you, step back and realise it. Let the challenge (she slams her staff down) begin

The instructions tell the warriors all they need to know to complete the challenge. First a series of arrows must be inputted correctly, then the colours of the words must be matched, then a riddle must be answered.

Each of the pairs are quick to work on this but with the noise of the other teams, all the warriors are having difficulty communicating. Tonro follows the instructions of Lerdan, correctly turning the dials so the arrows match what he was describing. Abbli, following the instructions of Valtho, soon followed by Kanem, following the instructions of Denal. Hamras, following the instructions of Leyad isn't far behind either but Pale, guiding Etoney are falling behind.

Ensuring that the warriors give the colours of each word and not the words themselves proves difficult for some but with clear instructions, Tonro has soon matched them and finds an assortment of keys.

"I am normally below you. If you remove my 1st letter, you'll find me above you. If you remove my 1st & 2nd letters, you can't see me. What am I?"

The pressure is on as Abbli, Denal and Leyad soon have deciphered the colours and unlocked the second lock. With Lerdan having read it aloud, Tonro works out the answer to the riddle, and finds the key to match it, exiting the cage with all 6 rings, 2 rings disappear from the cages of the remaining warriors.

Abbli finds the correct key and soon is also free of the cage, with 4 rings for him and Valtho. Kanem finds the correct key soon after and leaves with the 2 rings that remain in her cage. With all the rings gone, the other warriors race to survive as Etoney releases the second lock. Unfortunately, it's too late as Leyad manages to unlock his cage.

Raven: Etoney, it seems the key has eluded you. Do not worry (she swings her staff

and the cage disappears) you will not stay trapped forever

Abbli: Finally! Abbli gets a good moment!

Kanem: I think Escape the Cage went very well for me and Denal since we were able

to get the final rings. I knew I didn't want to lose another challenge and I'm

very glad we worked well together.

Hamras: Of course, I'm disappointed that my team didn't get any rings in this

challenge, but I feel that it is much better than losing a life. Winning this next challenge will definitely put me higher in the leader-board; so I pray to god

I'm not paired with the spider.

Denal: Me and Kanem worked well as a team. I'm glad it was her in the cage and not

me, that's for sure.

Valtho: I was really pleased to work with Abbli in this challenge, as I thought his

teamwork skills would be great for me to work with. While nobody got close to Tonro and Lerdan, we managed to nick second which is a great result. This

day has gone really well for me so far and I really hope it continues.

Lerdan: I felt that challenge went really well as me and Tonro managed to work

quickly and gained 6 rings.

Etoney: To begin I thought me and Pale would make a very good team but it seems

we didn't manage to get on the same page so I am quite disappointed because today I have now one 2 challenges and lost 2 so I'm starting to lose ground on the warriors in front of me but thankfully there's still a challenge

to go and I hope I can get back on track and win.

Pale: Our teamwork in all honesty was a complete disaster, looking back I think I

ought to have been in the cage as when I was giving the instructions Etoney didn't seem to understand them at all. To be fair he would probably have been better at giving instructions than taking them and I would have been better listening to the instructions in the cage so our organisation was a big mistake from our part there. That loss affected me badly as I am now down to

6th however I don't tend to stay there for long.

Leyad: I think this challenge could have gone a lot better as me and Hamras weren't

fast enough to get any of the rings. However, we did manage to keep all if our

lives and I've moved up to 4th place, which is great

Tonro: I'm elated to have won this challenge as it gives me some much-needed extra


rings

Raven: Lerdan, Tonro, you escaped the cage first, and earned 3 rings each






Raven: Valtho, Abbli, you escaped the cage and earned 2 rings apiece

Raven: Pale, Etoney, you failed to communicate effectively, and must lose a life





Raven:

Warriors, the rings you seek lie in the centre of the loch, but to reach them, you must use the floating stones, they are too far apart to jump across, so you must create a bridge using the boards. Beware, your opponent will be doing the same from the other side of the loch. Fall into the water, or get beaten to the rings, and you will lose a life. Lerdan, Valtho, you lead us currently, you shall race first.





Raven: Are you ready? Lerdan: Yes, Raven Valtho: Yes, Raven

Raven: Then let the challenge (she slams her staff down) begin

The challenge soon begins and both warriors use their board to progress onto the first stepping stone. Both are quick to take the board and make progress to the next one. The race continues as neither seem to be losing their balance.

Valtho edges out a small lead over Lerdan but the race remains close as they approach the rings in the centre of the loch. Valtho places down the board first and races to the final ring, grabbing it from right under Lerdan's nose.

Valtho: Once I found out I was facing Lerdan I knew I had to give it my best shot, as if

I lost I'd be over two lives behind first place again. It was really tense throughout the challenge as we seemed to be so close. I was chuffed, but

relieved to grab that ring at the end.

Lerdan: It was a really close race between me and Valtho and he managed to get the

ring as soon as I was about to get it which made me lose my win streak.





Raven: Are you ready?
Denal: Yes, Raven

Leyad: Yes, Raven

Raven: Let the challenge (she slams her staff down) begin

Both warriors quickly have their board down and proceed onto the first stone, Denal quickly gains a short lead over Leyad but this only increases Leyad's determination to catch up. As they approach the half-way point, Leyad is gaining.

Denal's lead continues to shorten as they proceed towards the ring but soon Leyad's hastes catches up with her and she falls into the water. This lucky break allows Denal to proceed peacefully to the rings.

Lerdan: I was guite worried when I saw that Denal was so far ahead if me, so I really

hurried to try and catch up with him Unfortunately, this lead to me falling into the water and losing a life, which I'm quite disappointed with myself for.

Denal: Leyad gave me a real challenge in this race, but I think she got a bit cocky and

made the same mistake I made in Eyeless Demons. Once she was in the drink I could go at my own pace. I'm still in 3rd overall and only a few rings behind

the leaders, so everything's still to play for.





Raven: Let the challenge (she slams her staff down) begin

Both warriors get the boards down, and begin progressing towards the middle, Pale maintains both speed and balance and makes swift progress. But Hamras is not deterred and makes fast progress as well.

Pale maintains his lead as they approach the final ring but Hamras is not giving up and begins closing the gap between them. Unfortunately, it's too late as Pale places down the board one final time and grabs the rings.

Hamras: I jinxed myself. I was confident when I saw the challenge, but that completely

evaporated as soon as I found out I was paired with the spider. But I did learn

something new in this challenge: spiders can walk on water.

Pale: To be honest that was one of the easiest challenges I competed in and I more

likely would have thrashed most of my fellow warriors on that challenge so I was very confident I would end up winning that challenge. To be fair Hamras was really pushing me the whole way as he is a very good warrior when it comes to his balance so I was a bit under pressure there, so I had to keep my speed up a lot in order to stay ahead of him and I am so glad that worked as that was the challenge I really had to win to put myself back into a strong

position.





Raven: Let the challenge (she slams her staff down) begin

The warriors place their boards down and head out onto the stones. Kanem immediately has issues maintaining her balance, but she holds her nerve and doesn't fall. In this time Etoney has gained a lead but he is experiencing balance issues of his own.

Kanem has another near-miss as she closes on the half-way point of the course, she holds it but it's too late as Etoney has manages to make it to the final stone. He places down the board once more and walks in to grasp the rings.

Kanem:

When I saw the progress Etoney was making in Stone Bridge, I was not sure what to do to speed up without falling in and he won as a result. Congratulations to him for winning but I hope to move ahead of more of the boys soon since I'm one of only 2 girls here.





Raven: (Slams her staff down) begin

They begin and immediately Abbli takes the lead over Tonro as Tonro struggles to maintain his balance on the wobbly stepping stones. Trying to catch up, Tonro slips on one of the stones, twisting his ankle and falling into the water.

Abbli, now safe from any interference, takes his time and progresses slowly towards the rings in the middle. He soon makes it to the final stone, places the board down and lays claim to the 2 rings he needs.


Abbli: Being in 9th so much I really can't afford to lose so it's great to win 2 in a row!

Tonro: After slipping on the stone I fractured my ankle and I'm not sure I can

continue on this quest.

Raven: Valtho, Denal, Pale, Etoney, Abbli, you all reached the rings, which I now

place on your standards. Pale, with these rings you've earned back a life



Raven: Kanem, Tonro, you fell into the water, and a life is forfeit



Raven: Lerdan, Hamras, Leyad, you may have kept dry but you lost the race and lose a life.



The warriors are gathered around Raven in a field

Raven: At this stage in the quest, the warrior in last place would face a trial to determine whether they'll stay in the quest. However, Tonro, you acquired an

injury in the last challenge, will you be able to continue (Tonro shakes his head) very well (she holds up her staff and Tonro disappears from view)

Leader-board
